In the Akan culture, women are upheld as quintessential beings and in this audacious rendering, we see four bold female figures take centre stage as goddesses on earth.

Note the word Goddess – etched backward to reflect Djéka's perspective on the importance of looking inwards into oneself, while the twisted pink umbilical cord amplifies Djéka's insistence on the value of upholding generational value chains.
