Kudita envisions African landscapes as dynamic, shaped by human presence. The resilient cactus, storing water for survival, parallels Gladys' intricately crafted pot – both vessels of life. African Pot celebrates the harmony between nature's resourceful vessels and human creation, blurring boundaries of tradition, anthropology, and aesthetics.
