The figure depicted, Dorothy, is a descendant of the Shaka Zulu family line, tracing her roots back to the Zulu kingdom of South Africa. Dorothy's family history embodies this ongoing journey, with ancestors migrating from South Africa to settle in Zimbabwe. The powerful image of the ship symbolizes the movement of people, highlighting the complex realities of having roots in different parts of the world due to forced or unforeseen circumstances.
