The process involves sourcing images from African archives, followed by a combination of traditional cut-and-paste techniques and digital collaging. Using archival paper, the

collages are carefully assembled to ensure both the preservation of the images and the vibrancy of the stories they tell. Through these visual narratives, The Ride Home delves into the depths of maternal bravery and the profound bonds that unite women across generations and cultures.
