Set against the backdrop of Johannesburg's dynamic cityscape, the artwork explores how the relentless hustle of their youth has shaped their adult lives, for better or worse. Ilunga reflects on the transformative journey of masculinity in the urban context, where societal pressures, cultural

expectations, and the pursuit of identity converge. The piece serves as a poignant commentary on the outcomes of ambition and resilience in a city that molds and defines its inhabitants.
