




"Seeking The Source I"

The use of yellow water containers serves as a symbol of necessity, labor, and the harsh realities of water scarcity, which burdens many communities worldwide.

Through expressive brushstrokes and a bold color palette, I aim to bring attention to the silent stories of these individuals—stories of perseverance, hope, and dignity in the face of hardship. By confronting viewers with the children's direct gazes, I hope to evoke empathy and a sense of shared responsibility for the inequalities that persist globally.
