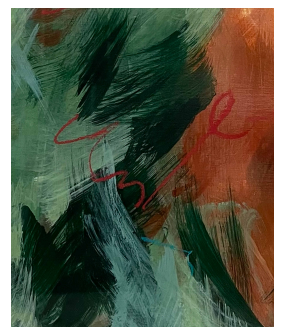
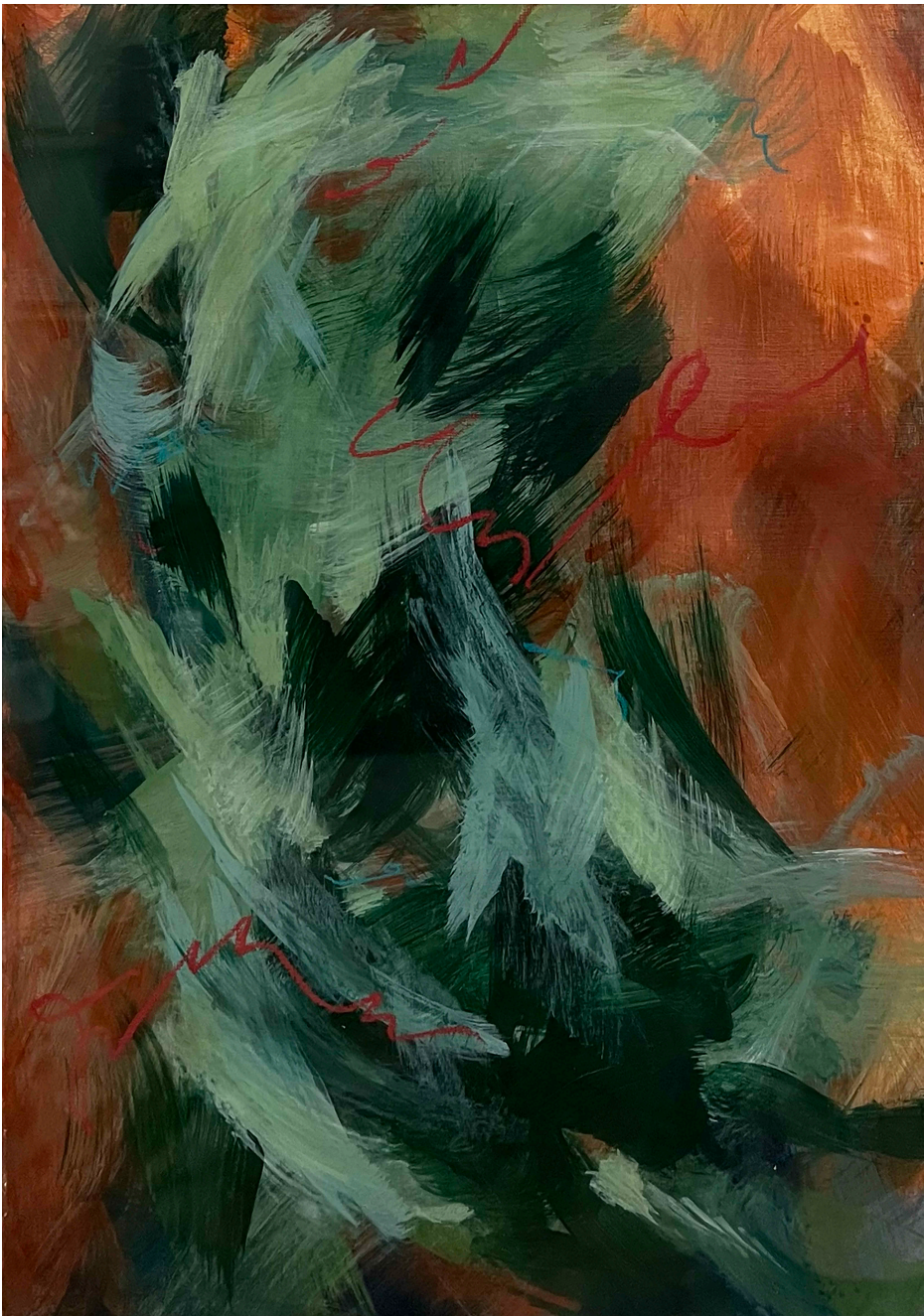
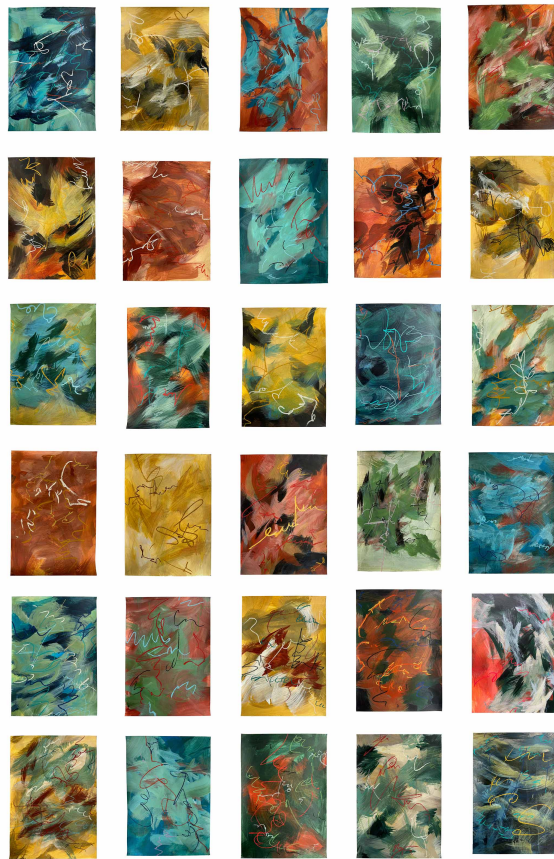




Tempest
