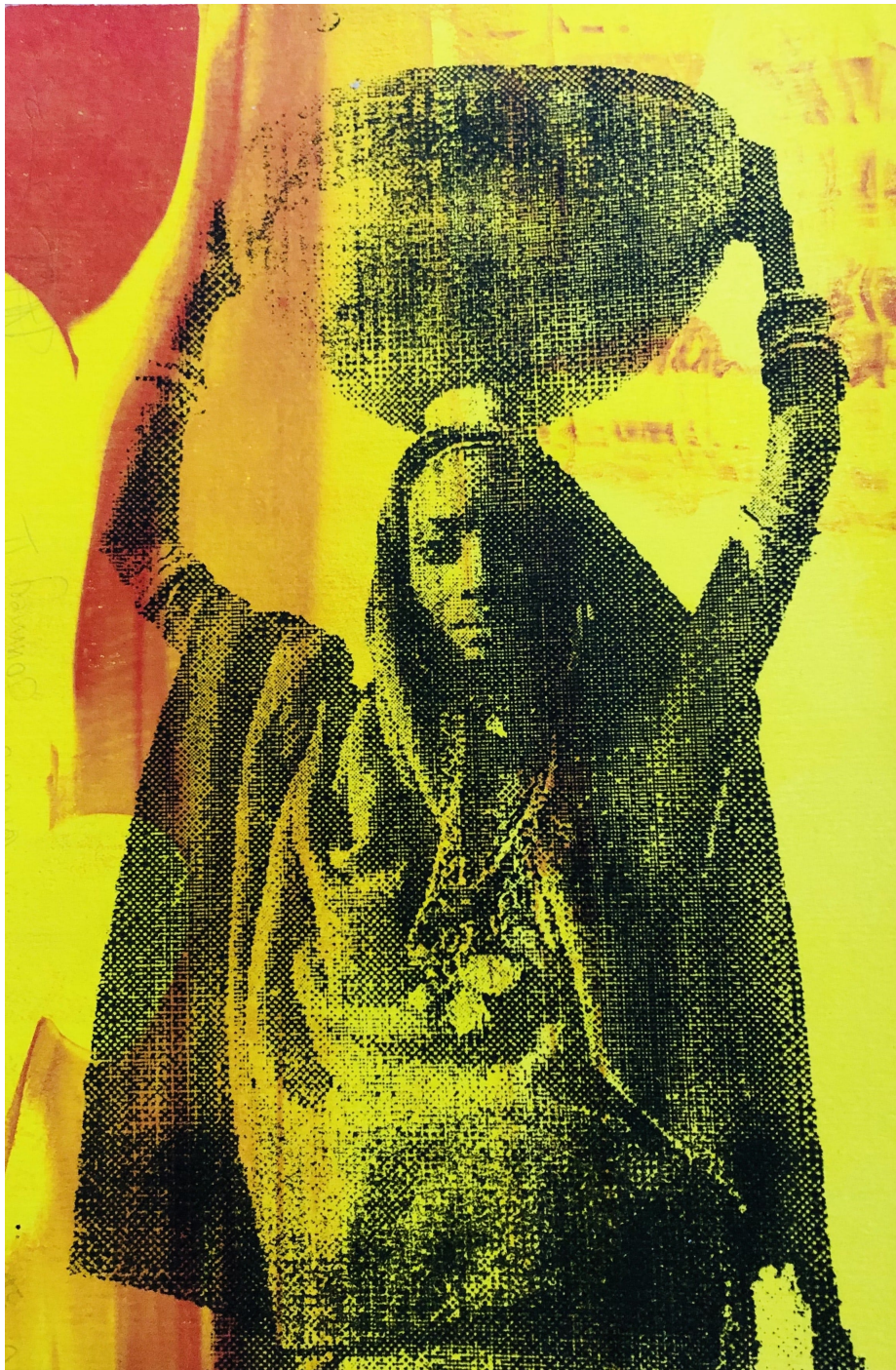




Mothers Journey
